Sunday, June 28 is also WPAFB Appreciation Day and anyone with a valid WPAFB ID is admitted free to both the CondoFest at Soraya Farms and the HomeFest at the Trails of SaddleCreek. Visit all seven homes at the Trails of SaddleCreek and three condos at Soraya Farms and you are eligible to win a trip for two to Orlando and gift certificates to Miami Valley Restaurant Association establishments. Please note the All American PetFest is being held only at Soraya Farms and pet sitters are not available at the Trails of SaddleCreek, so bring a friend to watch your pet while you tour the homes and vice versa.

The CondoFest location is **Soraya Farms** located in Clearcreek Township in Warren County on State Route 48 between Social Row Road and Lytle Five Points Road. CondoFest will feature a main street feel community with French country-style condominiums and patio homes.
